It's amazing to serve a God who's loving and who wants the best for us in every way. Life is great, but difficult things happen each day and God wants us to consider being happy in Him through it all. *Jeremiah 29:11* states, *For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.* Let's look at how we can have positive thoughts in the midst of some difficult times and experiences.

"I'm all alone" God show me who to reach out to."	"There are people who care. I won't stay silent.

Philippians 4:6 "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God."

E. G. White wrote, many thoughts make up the unwritten history of a single day, and these thoughts have much to do with the formation of character. Our thoughts are to be strictly guarded, for one impure thought makes a deep impression on the soul. An evil thought leaves an evil impress on the mind. If the thoughts are pure and holy, the man is better for having cherished them. By them the spiritual pulse is quickened and the power for doing good is increased.
